

received a request from the Idaho Weed Control Association requesting a rule that would provide a framework for certifying "noxious weed free gravel", similar to the rule currently in place for Noxious Weed Free Hay and Forage. It is expected that the rule will be drafted utilizing the Weed Free Hay and Forage rule as a framework. Gravel certification standards are available from the North American Weed Management Association (NAWMA).

The new rule will put a similar noxious weed free certification procedure in place for gravel which parallels the currently used Weed Free Hay and Forage Rule.
