The Environmental Care Association of Idaho supports the amendment of Subsection 02.03.03.500.02, Rules Governing Pesticide and Chemigation Use and Application, to eliminate the specific names of low volatile liquid ester formulations around any home or garden. There are newer products that are safer and more effective. We also support the amendment when it applies to the elimination of the restriction date of May 1 to October 1. A temperature restriction is a much better mechanism to reduce damage. As an organization we believe that this change is in the best interest of our profession.
