AGENDA ITEMS

Lloyd Knight convened the meeting at 10:00 a.m.

Diane Haas arrived at 11:15 a.m.

The purpose of the Idaho Hop Commission's (IHC) petition to amend the hops rules is to change the rule to include a quarantine area.

The group was directed to section 012 Regulated Pests, subsection 02 Powdery Mildew. A question was raised as to whether or not *Podosphaera macularis* (Wallr. Fr.), synonyms *Sphaerotheca macularis* (Wallr. Fr.) Lind and *Sphaerotheca humuli* (Burril) Lind. is the correct strain of powdery mildew. It was suggested to contact Dave Gent, USDA, at Oregon State University.

Under section 100, QUARANTINE AREA, it was discussed and decided that the alternative language: "All areas outside of the territorial borders of Idaho, Oregon and Washington" will be inserted into this section.

Under section 200, PERMITS, number 02 Conditions, it was discussed and recommended that language will be added to this section to the effect that all permitted material must pass through the Clean Health Facility and be found free of all regulated pests and diseases.

Under section 450, PENALTY, it was discussed and decided to reference the fee penalty, Title 22, Chapter 20, Idaho Code.
