General Information

As a conditional-use provision of this 24(c) labeling, the application of Supracide 2E on timothy or timothy-alfalfa stands intended primarily for haying, green chopping, or grazing for horses shall be restricted to the State of Idaho.

Timothy or Timothy-Alfalfa Stands

Apply at a rate of 2 pts to 4 pts per acre in a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre with ground equipment or 2 gallons of water per acre by air.

Chemigation: Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Bees: This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or broadleaf weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming alfalfa or broadleaf weeds. Apply as a pre-bloom spray, or control bloom prior to application.

Restrictions: To avoid illegal residues, (1) Do not apply within 21 days of harvest. (2) Do not allow any animal which will enter the human food chain to graze on Supracide-treated timothy or timothy-alfalfa. (3) Do not apply Supracide 2E at a rate exceeding 4 pints per acre (1 lb ai/A) per cutting. (4) Growers shall obtain a signed "Seed Conditioner and Hay Broker Notification" form from persons receiving hay, seed, or seed screening that have been treated. (5) The Seed Conditioner and Hay Broker Notification form shall be retained by the grower for a period of not less than two years.

HAY SELLER AND/OR BROKER STATEMENT

I hereby acknowledge the Timothy or Timothy-Alfalfa hay described above was received by me on (date) _____ and the following requirements and restrictions will be observed and followed:

- (1) All hay harvested from fields treated with Supracide 2E or products made from this hay (example: pellets) shall bear specific and conspicuous labeling on the shipment invoice, bill of sale, or bill of lading, which forbids the use of the hay as feed for pigs, chickens, cows or horses for horsemeat or any other animal that will become part of the human food chain in the U.S.A.
- (2) All hay harvested from fields treated with Supracide 2E will be managed in one of the following ways:
 1. Exported out of the U.S.A.
 2. Fed only to domestic horses not to be used for horsemeat.
 3. Incinerated, buried or composted.

IMPORTANT! This document to remain on file with the grower for a period of not less than two years. Second copy to also be signed by the broker/buyer and mailed to the Idaho Department of Agriculture by the grower within 7 days of delivery.
