#### **Directions for Use**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This label and the federally registered label must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

Mixing procedures: Apply Topsin M WSB as a water-based slurry utilizing standard slurry seed treatment equipment which provides uniform seed coverage. Uneven or incomplete seed coverage may not give the desired level of disease control. Thoroughly mix the recommended amount of Topsin M WSB into the required amount of water. Mix wettable powder first with water prior to adding flowables or liquid solution.

Seed treatment of sweet corn: Apply Topsin M WSB at the rate of 3.0 ounces per 100 pounds of seed.

Seed labeling: Treated seed must be labeled "For Export Only – Not to be Sold or Offered for Sale in the United States."

Note: Federal law requires that bags containing treated seeds shall be labeled with the following information: "This seed has been treated with thiophanate-methyl (Topsin M WSB). Do not use treated seed for feed, food, or oil purposes. Store away from feeds and foodstuffs."

Use with an EPA-approved dye which imparts an unnatural color to the seed. Do not apply this product for this use through any type of irrigation system.

Observe all applicable directions, restrictions, Worker Protection Standard requirements and precautions on the EPA registered label.
