2000 Laboratory Activities

The laboratory routinely assays for guaranteed values of protein, fat, vitamin A, fourteen minerals, twelve medications and two mycotoxins.

During 2000, a total of 1,082 samples of feeds or feed ingredients were received. Among these were 170 medicated products. These samples required 3,843 test procedures, exclusive of repeated tests for confirmation.

A total of 247 samples were declared violative. Of these, 51 were considered serious enough to warrant a stop-sale order.

Aflatoxin screens were conducted on 48 cottonseed products and 68 corn products. The same 68 corn products were also tested for fumonisin. No samples exceeded the 20 ppb or 5 ppm limits for aflatoxin and fumonisin respectively.

The following pages list the samples tested grouped by manufacturer or registrant. Violations are expressed as a percentage of the guarantee. A major violation generally results in a stop-sale order. Violation guidelines are as follows:

competent jurisdiction in the area in which said commercial feed is located. In the event the court finds the said commercial feed to be in violation of the provisions of this chapter and orders the condemnation of said commercial feed, it shall be disposed of in any manner consistent with the quality of the commercial feed and the laws of the state: provided, that in no instance shall the disposition of said commercial feed be ordered by the court without first giving the claimant an opportunity to apply to the court for release of said commercial feed or for permission to process or relabel said commercial feed to bring it into compliance with the provisions of this chapter.

25-2726. Penalties for violations. a. Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this chapter or the rules and regulations issued thereunder or who shall impede, obstruct, hinder, or otherwise prevent or attempt to prevent said director or a duly authorized agent in performance of their duty in connection with the provisions of this chapter, shall be adjudged guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500) for the first violation, and not more than one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) for a subsequent violation. In all prosecutions under the provisions of this chapter involving the composition of a lot of commercial feed, a certified copy of the official analysis signed by the director shall be accepted as prima facie evidence of the composition.

b. Any person who violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this chapter or any regulations promulgated under this chapter may be assessed a civil penalty by the department or its duly authorized agent of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500) for each offense and shall be liable for reasonable attorney fees. Assessment of a civil penalty may be made in conjunction with any other department administrative action. No civil penalty may be assessed unless the person charged was given notice and opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Idaho administrative procedure act. If the director is unable to collect such penalty or if any person fails to pay all or a set portion of the civil penalty as determined by the department, it may recover such amount by action in the appropriate district court. Any person against whom the director has assessed a civil penalty under the provisions of this section may, within thirty (30) days of the final action by the agency making the assessment, appeal the assessment to the district court of the county in which the violation is alleged by the department to have occurred. Moneys collected for violation of a rule or regulation shall be remitted to the feed and fertilizer

In the event that a state government or Federal government laboratory is not available, an independent or company laboratory may upon request be approved by the Department. 550. COTTONSEED -- EXEMPTIONS.

Cottonseed hulls are exempted from laboratory certification requirements as stated in section 500.01 through 500.04, provided that, cottonseed hulls shall not contain greater than twenty (20) ppb aflatoxin as required by the U. S. Food and Drug Administration. Any invoice or bill of lading accompanying or sent in regard to a shipment of cottonseed hulls shall state the level of aflatoxin in parts per billion contained in the shipment. (4-21-92)

600. DETAINED COMMERCIAL FEEDS.

01. Withdrawn From Sale. A commercial feed that is the subject of a "withdrawal from sale" order under Section 25-2725(a), Idaho Code, may be released from such an order by the following means: (4-21-92)

a. A commercial feed detained for nutritional violation(s) may be: (4-21-92)

i. Remanufactured, using ingredients listed on the approved label, to meet label guarantees. The remixed feed shall be resampled and analyzed to ensure compliance prior to its return to sale. (4-21-92)

ii. Relabeled to reflect actual values, upon approval of a new label and registration, provided that these values are appropriate for their intended use. (4-21-92)

iii. Returned to the manufacturer if the seller and manufacturer are not the same. (4-21-92)

iv. Diverted to an alternate use such as inclusion into another feed, or feeding to the manufacturer's own livestock, provided that it is appropriate for the diverted use and that it does not conflict with labeling or other State or Federal requirements for the diverted use. (4-21-92)

v. Destroyed. (4-21-92)

b. A commercial feed detained for a drug or antibiotic violation may be: (4-21-92)

i. Remanufactured to meet label guarantees. The remixed feed shall be resampled and analyzed prior to its return to sale. (4-21-92)

ii. Returned to the manufacturer if the seller and manufacturer are not the same. (4-21-92)

iii. Diverted to an alternate use, provided that it is appropriate for the diverted use and does not conflict with labeling or other State or Federal requirements for the diverted use. (4-21-92)

iv. Destroyed. (4-21-92)

c. A commercial feed deemed to be adulterated under Section 25-2721(a), Idaho Code, or which cannot safely be remanufactured, relabeled, or diverted to an alternate use may be: (4-21-92)

i. Returned to the manufacturer if the seller and manufacturer are not the same. (4-21-92)

ii. Destroyed. (4-21-92)

02. Appropriate Compliance Procedure. The Department shall indicate which of the above listed compliance procedures are appropriate for the particular "withdrawal from sale" order. The seller shall indicate which procedure is to be followed and, upon approval from the Department, shall carry out the procedure within thirty (30) days. Other procedures may be considered upon application by the state inspector or seller to the Chief, Bureau of Feeds and Plant Services, Idaho Department of Agriculture, Boise, Idaho. (4-21-92)

Good Manufacturing Requirements for Non Registered Feed Mills

1. **Building and Grounds**
 - Must provide space for equipment, processing of feeds and receipt and storage of medications.
 - Must allow access to all feed equipment for maintenance, cleaning and inspection.
 - Must be constructed and maintained to minimize vermin and pest infestation.
2. **Equipment**
 - Must be capable of producing the amount of medicated feed that is normally run through the facility. Mixers should not be over-filled.
 - Must be built and maintained to allow for clean-out and inspection. This includes the inside and outside of a piece of equipment.
 - Must be kept in a clean and orderly condition.
 - Scales and liquid meters must be capable of measuring in the divisions used.
 - Scales must be checked at least once a year by a licensed service company.
3. **Records**
 - Commercial or Customer Formula medicated feeds must have the date of mixing, be signed or initialed by a qualified person, and the date of formulation must be kept on file for one year. These records should include the lot number of the drug premix used in them.
 - Should be adequate enough to help recall any feeds that are adulterated.
4. **Work and Storage Areas**
 - Fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, lubricants, motor oil, and other products that are not feed additives shall be kept physically separate from work areas used for feeds.
 - Work areas and equipment used for the manufacture and storage of fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, lubricants, motor oil, and other products that are not feed additives shall be kept physically separate from work areas used for feeds.
5. **Drugs and/or Medications**
 - Can only be mixed and used according to label directions.
 - Should be stored in original closed containers.
 - Requiring 1900 approval cannot be used without that approval.
 - Received must have receipt records showing identification lot, amount and name of drugs/medications.
 - Opened and in use must maintain their identity, strength and purity (keep in original containers (rolled down) or if dumped into a barrel, the name of product, drug level, lot number, and labeler must be transferred to the barrel).
 - In bulk must be identified and stored in a manner to maintain their integrity, quality and purity.
6. **Samples**
 - Samples are not required for non-1900 drugs. However, if samples are taken (including official state samples) and the results are out of tolerance, then a follow-up investigation must be completed, and recorded with the corrective action taken and maintained for one year.
7. **Procedures**
 - Must be in writing and maintained at the facility for clean-out of equipment.
 - Must be established in writing for proper mixing of all medicated feeds, include mixing time and when medications are added to the batch.
8. **Labels**
 - Received labels shall be stored and handled to prevent the wrong labels being attached to feeds.
 - Must be sent with all feed delivered in either bag or bulk including custom mixed feed.

BSE AND ANIMAL HEALTH

What it means for renderers, protein blenders, feed manufacturers, feed distributors, and feeders of ruminant animals (with or without on-farm feed mixing operations).

The Federal Mammalian Protein Feeding Ban

- **Purpose**

The purpose of the ban is to prevent the establishment and amplification of bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE) in the United States through feed, and thereby minimize any risk to animals and humans. BSE is a progressive degenerative brain disease of cattle that is 100% fatal. At the present time, only postmortem confirmation is possible.

Dairy and beef cattle producers are now prohibited from feeding protein feed ingredients made from rendered mammalian tissue. Feed manufacturers, protein blenders, and rendering companies are required to label any feeds or feed ingredients containing prohibited material with the warning statement: "Do Not Feed To Cattle Or Other Ruminants."

- **Effective Date**

U.S. Food and Drug Administration regulation 21 CFR 589.2000 prohibits feeding protein derived from the tissues of mammals to ruminant animals (any animal with a four-chambered stomach) such as cattle, sheep, goats, deer, elk, bison and buffalo. This rule became effective on August 4, 1997.

- **What Is Included in the Ban**

Feed ingredients or feeds containing ingredients that are derived from mammals and supply protein are considered "prohibited material" unless otherwise specifically exempted.

- Examples: meat, glandular meat, meat and bone meal, meat and bone meal tankage, meat by-products, hydrolyzed hair, cooked or steamed bone meal, bone marrow and leather meal.

- **What Is Not Included in the Ban**

The following protein products derived from mammals are exempt:

- Blood and blood products; milk products (milk and milk proteins); pure porcine (pork) or pure equine (horse) protein products; inspected meat products (such as plate waste) which have been cooked and offered for human consumption and further heat processed for animal feed; and gelatin.

The following non-mammalian protein products are exempt:

- Poultry, marine (fish), and vegetable.

The following products are also exempt because they are not protein or tissue:

- Grease, tallow, fat, oil, amino acids and dicalcium phosphate.

We refer to the exempted products throughout this guide as “non-prohibited material.”

Complying with the new regulations

- **Requirements for Renderers**

A. Firms that do not separate prohibited and non-prohibited materials need to:

- Label all outgoing products that contain or may contain prohibited material with the following statement: “Do Not Feed To Cattle Or Other Ruminants.”
- Maintain records sufficient to track the materials throughout their receipt, processing, and distribution, and make the records available for inspection and copying by FDA. Invoices or similar documents for incoming and outgoing products will satisfy this requirement. The records should contain information normally expected to be included in such documents.
- Maintain records for a minimum of one year.

B. Firms that do not separate prohibited from non-prohibited materials have three additional requirements:

- Obtain non-prohibited material (including pure pork and pure equine) only from single species slaughter facilities. Single species slaughter facilities are those that are dedicated solely to the slaughter of a single species of animal.
- Provide for measures to avoid commingling or cross-contamination of prohibited and non-prohibited materials.
- Maintain written procedures that document measures adopted to prevent commingling or cross-contamination.

- **Requirements for Protein Blenders, Feed Manufacturers, and Distributors**

A. Firms that handle only prohibited material, or handle both prohibited and non-prohibited material, but do not separate them, need to:

- Label all outgoing products that contain or may contain prohibited material with the following statement: “Do Not Feed To Cattle Or Other Ruminants.”
- Maintain records sufficient to track the materials throughout their receipt, processing and distribution, and make the records available for inspection and copying. Invoices

or similar documents for incoming and outgoing products will satisfy this requirement. The records should contain information normally expected to be included in such documents.

- Maintain the records for a minimum of one year.
- B. Firms that do not separate prohibited from non-prohibited materials have two additional requirements:
- Provide for the measures to avoid commingling or cross-contamination of prohibited and non-prohibited materials.
 - Maintain written procedures that document the measures adopted to prevent commingling or cross-contamination.
- **Requirements for Feeders of Ruminant Animals with On-Farm Feed Mixing Operations**
 - Do not mix feed for ruminant animals using feed ingredients labeled with the caution statement: “Do Not Feed To Cattle Or Other Ruminants.”
 - If mixing feed for both ruminant and non-ruminant animals, and prohibited material for non-ruminant animal feed is used:
 - Utilize separation or clean-out procedures to avoid commingling and cross contamination.
 - Maintain written procedures that are developed and implement to prevent commingling and cross contamination.
 - Keep records sufficient to track the prohibited materials through their receipt, processing, and distribution, and make them available for inspection and copying.
 - If mixing feed for non-ruminant animals using prohibited material and it leaves your immediate control (e.g. shipped to a contract grower), it must be labeled with the cautionary statement: “Do Not Feed To Cattle Or Other Ruminants,” and records of the delivery must be maintained.
 - If complete feed is also purchased (feed that is not mixed before feeding):
 - Maintain copies of all purchase invoices and labeling for **ALL** feed received that contain **animal protein** products. Keep invoices and labeling available for inspection and copying.
 - Maintain all required records for at least one year.
- **Requirements for Feeders of Ruminant Animals without On-Farm Feed Mixing Operations**
 - Do not feed products labeled with the caution statement “Do Not Feed To Cattle Or Other Ruminants” to ruminant animals.
 - Maintain copies of all purchase invoices for **ALL** feed products received that contain **animal protein** products.
 - Keep invoices and labeling available for inspection and copying.
 - Maintain the records for a minimum of one year.

FEED LABELING ADVISORY FOR THE COMPLIANCE OF THE MAMMALIAN-TO-RUMINANT FEED BAN

FINAL REGULATIONS PUBLISHED BY THE FDA ON JUNE 5, 1997
EFFECTIVE DATE: AUGUST 4, 1997

New labeling requirements for feeds containing mammalian protein have been finalized by the Food and Drug Administration. Animal feed containing protein derived from mammals may contain the disease agent that causes transmissible spongiform encephalopathy (TSE) in animals. Epidemiological evidence gathered in the United Kingdom suggests a link between an outbreak of mammalian TSE, specifically bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE or Mad Cow Disease), and feeding animals protein derived from mammals. Additional data suggests that exposure to BSE may explain some of the recent cases of variant Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease in the U.K. Although BSE has not been diagnosed in the United States, this action is to ensure the health of animals and reduce any risk to humans.

PROHIBITED: All mammalian protein (except listed exemptions) in animal feeds

EXEMPTIONS: Swine protein, equine protein, blood and blood products, milk and milk products, plate waste, gelatin, grease, tallow, amino acids, dicalcium phosphate, fat, oils

The cautionary statement, “**DO NOT FEED TO CATTLE OR OTHER RUMINANTS.**”, must appear on all feed labels containing prohibited mammalian protein. Only pet foods for retail sale and feeds for non-ruminant laboratory animals are exempt from using the cautionary statement.

The cautionary statement should be distinguished by different type size or color or other means of highlighting the statement. For existing labeling, a rubber stamp or stick-on labels with the cautionary statement may be used.

Collective terms can be made more specific to show that the feed does not contain prohibited mammalian protein. For example, pork and bone meal can be used, when appropriate, instead of meat and bone meal.

Idaho State feed inspectors will be checking for proper feed labeling at feed outlets. Labels that were printed after these regulations were enacted may not be used after October 3, 1997, if they are not in compliance. MYCOTOXINS AND ANIMAL FEEDS

Mycotoxins are harmful chemicals produced by various molds under specific conditions. The presence of mold is not a reliable indicator of toxins, nor is the absence of visible mold an indicator of the lack of toxins.

Types of Toxins

1. AFLATOXINS:

- Measured in parts per billion (ppb)
- Produced by strains of Aspergillus flavus and Aspergillus parasiticus
- Toxic and carcinogenic
- There are four types: B1, B2, G1 and G2; B1 is the most prevalent and the most toxic
- Aflatoxins M1 and M2 may appear in the milk of dairy animals that have consumed aflatoxin contaminated feed or grain
- Crops most affected are: corn, peanuts, cotton (cottonseed), coconut and tree nuts
- Wide range of symptoms include: immune system may weaken and reproductive systems may be affected
- Long term, low level exposure has been correlated to cancer
- Sensitivity varies among species
- The liver is a primary target

2. FUMONISIN:

- Measured in parts per million (ppm)
- Produced by strains of Fusarium moniliforme, a fungus commonly found in corn
- There are three types: B1, B2 and B3; B1 is the most common
- Fumonisin is the cause of equine leukoencephalomania (ELEM) and porcine pulmonary edema syndrome

3. VOMITOXIN (DON or deoxynivalenol):

- Measured in parts per million (ppm)
- Produced by several fungi, especially Fusarium graminearum
- Mostly found on cereal commodities: wheat, corn, barley and ensilages
- Symptoms include: vomiting, feed refusal, gastroenteritis, diarrhea, immune suppression and blood disorders
- Pigs are especially sensitive, and dogs may be as well

State Requirements

State law requires that any load of cottonseed or cottonseed seed products destined for Idaho be accompanied by a "Certificate of Analysis" certifying the aflatoxin level in the shipment to 20 parts per billion (ppb) or less if being fed to dairy cattle. Several incidents of cottonseed shipments exceeding this tolerance have been recorded in Idaho. Cottonseed and cottonseed meal may be imported into Idaho certified at aflatoxin levels of up to 300 parts per billion (ppb) to be fed to finishing beef cattle under a special permit from the Idaho State Department of Agriculture.

Management Practices

Piles of cottonseed can develop "hot spots" of aflatoxin levels when left in piles or railcars too long, or when left in transit too long. Cottonseed that may have been certified at only a few parts per billion (ppb) initially may grow to unsafe levels under the proper environmental conditions. Cottonseed initially certified at 15-20 parts per billion (ppb) stands a good chance of exceeding safe levels by delivery.

- Obtain shipments that are as fresh as possible to avoid or reduce risk
- Ask for a copy of the "Certificate of Analysis" when making purchases
- Store cottonseed and cottonseed seed products out of the weather if at all possible
- Utilize piles of cottonseed and cottonseed seed products in a timely manner

Laboratory Tests

Lab tests utilize the ELISA method. The Plant Industries lab tests include:

Aflatoxin:

- Cottonseed and corn
- Lower limit ~5 parts per billion(ppb)

Fumonisin:

- Corn
- Lower limit 1 part per million(ppm)

Vomitoxin:

- Wheat
- Lower limit 1 part per million(ppm)

account.

c. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed as requiring the director or a duly authorized representative to report for prosecution or for the institution of seizure proceedings as a result of minor violations of the act when the director believes that the public interest will be best served by a suitable notice of warning in writing.

d. It shall be the duty of each prosecuting attorney to whom any violation is reported to cause appropriate proceedings to be instituted and prosecuted in a court of competent jurisdiction without delay. Before the director reports a violation for such prosecution, an opportunity shall be given the distributor to present his view to the director.

e. The director is hereby authorized to apply for and the court to grant a temporary or permanent injunction restraining any person from violating or continuing to violate any of the provisions of this chapter or any rules or regulation promulgated under the chapter notwithstanding the existence of other remedies at law. Said injunction to be issued without bond.

25-2727. Publications. The director shall publish at least annually, in such forms as he may deem proper, information concerning the sales of commercial feeds, together with such data on their production and use as he may consider advisable, and a report of the results of the analyses of official samples of commercial feeds sold within the state as compared with the analyses guaranteed in the registration and on the label; provided, however, that the information concerning production and use of commercial feeds shall not disclose the operations of any person and the information shall be subject to disclosure according to chapter 3, title 9, Idaho Code.

25-2728. cooperation with other entities. The director may cooperate with and enter into agreements with governmental agencies of this state, other states, agencies of the federal government, private associations, and commercial feed manufacturers in order to carry out the purpose and provisions of this chapter.

RULES UNDER THE IDAHO COMMERCIAL FEED LAW
(Adopted by Provision of Idaho Code 22-103 and 25-2724)

000. -- 009. (RESERVED)

010. DEFINITIONS AND TERMS.

The names and definitions for commercial feeds shall be the Official Definition of Feed Ingredients adopted by the Association of American Feed Control Officials, (AAFCO) except as the Director designates otherwise in specific cases. The terms used in reference to commercial feeds shall be the Official Feed Terms adopted by the AAFCO, except as the Director designates otherwise in specific cases. The definitions and terms referred to are listed in the Official Publication of the Association of American Feed Control Officials. Copies are on file at: Idaho Department of Agriculture, Idaho State Law Library, and Idaho Legislative Council. (4-21-92)

011. -- 049. (RESERVED)

050. LABEL FORMAT.

01. Label Format. Commercial feeds shall be labeled with the information prescribed in this rule on the principal display panel of the product and in the following general format.

(8-16-71)

a. Net Weight. (8-16-71)

b. Product name and brand name if any. (8-16-71)

c. If a drug is used: (8-16-71)

i. The word "Medicated" shall appear directly following and below the product name in type size, no smaller than one-half (1/2) the type size of the product name. (8-16-71)

ii. The purpose of medication (claim statement).

iii. An active drug ingredient statement listing the active drug ingredients by their established name and the amounts in accordance with Subsection 150.04. (8-16-71)

iv. The required directions for use and precautionary statements or reference to their location if the detailed feeding directions and precautionary statements required by Sections 250 and 300 appear elsewhere on the label. (8-16-71)

d. The guaranteed analysis of the feed as required under the provisions of Section 25-2718(a)(3) of the Commercial Feed Law include the following items, unless exempted in Section 150.01.d.viii., and in the order listed: (8-16-71)

i. Minimum percentage of crude protein. (8-16-71)

ii. Maximum or minimum percentage of equivalent protein from non-protein nitrogen as required in Section 150.05. (8-16-71)

iii. Minimum percentage of crude fat. (8-16-71)

iv. Maximum percentage of crude fiber. (8-16-71)

v. Minerals, to include, in the following order: minimum and maximum percentages of calcium (Ca), minimum percentage of phosphorus (P), minimum and maximum percentages of salt (NaCl), and other minerals. (8-16-71)

vi. Vitamins in such terms as specified in Section 150.03. (8-16-71)

vii. Total sugars as invert on dried molasses products or products being sold primarily for their sugar content. (8-16-71)

viii. Exemptions. Guarantees for minerals are not required when there are no specific label claims and when the commercial feed contains less than six and one-half percent (6 1/2%) of Calcium, Phosphorus, Sodium and Chloride. Guarantees for vitamins are not required when the commercial feed is neither formulated for nor represented in any manner as a vitamin supplement. Guarantees for crude protein, crude fat, and crude fiber are not required when the commercial feed is intended for purposes other than to furnish these substances or they are of minor significance relating to the primary purpose of the product, such as drug premixes, mineral or vitamin supplements, and molasses. (8-16-71)

e. Feed ingredients, collective terms for the grouping of feed ingredients, or appropriate statements as provided under the provisions of Section 25-2718(a)(4) of the Commercial Feed Law. (8-16-71)

i. The name of each ingredient as defined in the Official Publication of the Association of American Feed Control Officials, common or usual name, or one approved by the Director. (8-16-71)

ii. Collective terms for the grouping of feed ingredients as defined in the Official Definitions of Feed Ingredients published in the Official Publication of the Association of American Feed Control Officials in lieu of the individual ingredients; Provided that: When a collective term for a group of ingredients is used on the label, individual ingredients within that group shall not be listed on the label. The manufacturer shall provide the feed control official, upon request, with a list of individual ingredients within a defined group, that are or have been used at manufacturing facilities distributing in or into the state. (8-16-71)

iii. The registrant may affix the statement, "ingredients as registered with the State" in lieu of the ingredient list on the label. The list of ingredients must be on file with the Director. This list shall be made available to the feed purchaser upon request. (8-16-71)

f. Name and principal mailing address of the manufacturer or person responsible for distributing the feed. The principal mailing address shall include the street address, city, state, and zip code; however the street address may be omitted if it is shown in the current city directory or telephone directory. (8-16-71)

g. The information required in Section 25-2718 of the Commercial Feed Law must appear in its entirety on one side of the label or on one side of the container. (8-16-71)

02. Customer formula Invoice And Tag Requirements. (8-16-71)

a. Bulk shipments of customer-formula feed shall be accompanied by an invoice, delivery slip or other shipping documents identifying the shipment as customer-formula feed and the name and address of the customer to whose order it is made. (8-16-71)

b. Bagged customer-formula feed will be labeled with a tag identifying each bag as such. The total bags in each customer's shipment will be segregated from other bagged feed

and identified with the name and address of the customer to whose order it is made. (8-16-71)

051. -- 099. (RESERVED)

100. BRAND AND PRODUCT NAMES.

01. Intended Use. The brand or product name must be appropriate for the intended use of the feed and must not be misleading. If the name indicates the feed is made for a specific use, the character of the feed must conform therewith. A mixture labeled "Dairy Feed," for example, must be suitable for that purpose. (8-16-71)

02. Listings. Commercial, registered brand or trade names are not permitted in guarantees of ingredient listings and only in the product name of feeds produced by or for the firm holding the rights to such a name. (8-16-71)

03. Name of Feed. The name of a commercial feed shall not be derived from one or more ingredients of a mixture to the exclusion of other ingredients and shall not be one representing any components of a mixture unless all components are included in the name: Provided, that if any ingredient or combination of ingredients is intended to impart a distinctive characteristic to the product which is of significance to the purchaser, the name of that ingredient or combination of ingredients may be used as part of the brand name or product name if the ingredient or combination of ingredients is quantitatively guaranteed in the guaranteed analysis, and the brand or product name is not otherwise false or misleading. (8-16-71)

04. Protein. The word "protein" shall not be permitted in the product name of a feed that contains added non-protein nitrogen. (8-16-71)

05. Percentage Value. When the name carries a percentage value, it shall be understood to signify protein and/or equivalent protein content only, even though it may not explicitly modify the percentage with the word "protein": Provided, that other percentage values may be permitted if they are followed by the proper description and conform to good labeling practice. Digital numbers shall not be used in such a manner as to be misleading or confusing to the customer. (8-16-71)

06. Single Ingredient. Single ingredient feeds shall have a product name in accordance with the designated definition of feed ingredients as recognized by the Association of American Feed Control Officials unless the Director designates otherwise.
(8-16-71)

07. Vitamin. The word "vitamin," or a contraction thereof, or any word suggesting vitamin can be used only in the name of a feed which is represented to be a vitamin supplement, and which is labeled with the minimum content of each vitamin declared, as specified in Section 150.03. (8-16-71)

08. Mineralized. The term "mineralized" shall not be used in the name of a feed except for "TRACE MINERALIZED SALT." When so used, the product must contain significant amounts of trace minerals which are recognized as essential for animal nutrition.
(8-16-71)

09. Meat and Meat By-Products. The term "meat" and "meat by-products" shall be qualified to designate the animal from which the meat and meat by-products is derived unless the meat and meat by-products are made from cattle, swine, sheep and goats. (8-16-71)

101. -- 149. (RESERVED)

150. EXPRESSION OF GUARANTEES.

01. Percentage by Weight. The guarantees for crude protein, equivalent protein from non-protein nitrogen, crude fat, crude fiber and mineral guarantees (when required) will be in terms of percentage by weight. (8-16-71)

02. Commercial Feeds. Commercial feeds containing six and one-half percent (6 1/2%) or more Calcium, Phosphorus, Sodium and Chloride shall include in the guaranteed analysis the minimum and maximum percentages of calcium (Ca), the minimum percentage of phosphorus (P), and if salt is added, the minimum and maximum percentage of salt (NaCl). Minerals, except salt (NaCl) shall be guaranteed in terms of percentage of the element. When calcium and/or salt guarantees are given in the guaranteed analysis such shall be stated and conform to the following: (8-16-71)

a. When the minimum is five percent (5.0%) or less, the maximum shall not exceed the minimum by more than one (1) percentage point. (8-16-71)

b. When the minimum is above five percent (5.0%), the maximum shall not exceed the minimum by more than twenty percent (20%) and in no case shall the maximum exceed the minimum by more than five (5) percentage points. (8-16-71)

03. Vitamin Content. Guarantees for minimum vitamin content of commercial feeds and feed supplements, when made, shall be stated on the label in milligrams per pound of feed except that: (8-16-71)

a. Vitamin A, other than precursors of Vitamin A, shall be stated in International or USP units per pound. (8-16-71)

b. Vitamin D, in products offered for poultry feeding, shall be stated in International Chick Units per pound. (8-16-71)

c. Vitamin D for other uses shall be stated in International or USP units per pound. (8-16-71)

d. Vitamin E shall be stated in International USP units per pound. (8-16-71)

e. Guarantees for vitamin content on the label of a commercial feed shall state the guarantee as true vitamins, not compounds, with the exception of the compounds, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride, Choline Chloride, Thiamine, and d-Pantothenic Acid. (8-16-71)

f. Oils and premixes containing vitamin A or vitamin D or both may be labeled to show vitamin content in terms of units per gram. (8-16-71)

04. Drugs. Guarantees for drugs shall be stated in terms of percent by weight, except: (8-16-71)

a. Antibiotics present at less than two thousand (2,000) grams per ton (total) of commercial feed shall be stated in grams per ton of commercial feed. (8-16-71)

b. Antibiotics present at two thousand (2,000) or more grams per ton (total) of commercial feed shall be stated in grams per pound of commercial feed. (8-16-71)

c. Labels for commercial feeds containing growth promotion and/or feed efficiency levels of antibiotics, which are to be fed continuously as the sole ration, are not required

to make quantitative guarantees except as specifically noted in the Federal Food Additive Regulations for certain antibiotics, wherein, quantitative guarantees are required regardless of the level or purpose of the antibiotic. (8-16-71)

d. The term "milligrams per pound" may be used for drugs or antibiotics in those cases where a dosage is given in "milligrams" in the feeding directions. (8-16-71)

05. Non-Protein Nitrogen. Commercial feeds containing any added non-protein nitrogen shall be labeled as follows:
(8-16-71)

a. For ruminants: (8-16-71)

i. Complete feeds, supplements, and concentrates containing added non-protein nitrogen and containing more than five percent (5%) protein from natural sources shall be guaranteed as follows:

Crude Protein, minimum, _____ %
(This includes not more than _____ % equivalent non-protein nitrogen.) (8-16-71)

ii. Mixed feed concentrates and supplements containing less than five percent (5%) protein from natural sources may be guaranteed as follows:

Equivalent Crude Protein from Non-Protein Nitrogen, minimum %.
(8-16-71)

iii. Ingredient sources of non-protein nitrogen such as Urea, Di-Ammonium Phosphate, Ammonium Polyphosphate Solution, Ammoniated Rice Hulls, or other basic non-protein nitrogen ingredients defined by the Association of American Feed Control Officials shall be guaranteed as follows:

Nitrogen, minimum _____ %
Equivalent Crude Protein from Non-Protein Nitrogen, minimum %
(8-16-71)

b. For non-ruminants: (8-16-71)

i. Complete feeds, supplements and concentrates containing crude protein from all forms of non-protein nitrogen, added as such, shall be labeled as follows:

Crude protein, minimum _____ %
(This includes not more than _____ % equivalent crude protein which is not nutritionally available to species of animal for which feed is intended.) (8-16-71)

ii. Premixes, concentrates or supplements intended for non-ruminants containing more than one and twenty-five hundredths percent (1.25%) equivalent crude protein from all forms of non-protein nitrogen, added as such, must contain adequate directions for use and a prominent statement: "WARNING: This feed must be used only in accordance with directions furnished on the label." (8-16-71)

06. Mineral Phosphate Materials. Mineral phosphatic materials for feeding purposes shall be labeled with the guarantee for minimum and maximum percentage of calcium (when present), the minimum percentage of phosphorus, and the maximum percentage of fluorine. (8-16-71)

151. -- 199. (RESERVED)

200. INGREDIENTS.

01. Name. The name of each ingredient or collective term for the grouping of ingredients, when required to be listed, shall be the name as defined in the Official Definitions of Feed Ingredients as published in the Official Publication of American Feed Control Officials, the common or usual name, or one approved by the Director. (8-16-71)

02. Same Size. The name of each ingredient must be shown in letters or type of the same size. (8-16-71)

03. Quality Or Grade. No reference to quality or grade of an ingredient shall appear in the ingredient statement of a feed. (8-16-71)

04. Dehydrated. The term "dehydrated" may precede the name of any product that has been artificially dried. (8-16-71)

05. Single Ingredient. A single ingredient product defined by the Association of American Feed Control Officials or by the Director is not required to have an ingredient statement. (8-16-71)

06. Tentative Definitions. Tentative definitions for ingredients shall not be used until adopted as official, unless no official definition exists or the ingredient has a common accepted name that requires no definition, (e.g. sugar). (8-16-71)

07. Iodized. When the word "iodized" is used in connection with a feed ingredient, the feed ingredient shall contain not less than seven thousandths percent (0.007%) iodine, uniformly distributed. (8-16-71)

201. -- 249. (RESERVED)

250. DIRECTIONS FOR USE AND PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS.

01. Labeling. Directions for use and precautionary statements on the labeling of all commercial feeds containing additives (including drugs, special purpose additives, or non-nutritive additives) shall: (8-16-71)

a. Be adequate to enable safe and effective use for the intended purposes by users with no special knowledge of the purpose and use of such articles; and, (8-16-71)

b. Include, but not be limited to, all information described by all applicable regulations under the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act. (8-16-71)

02. Non-Protein Nitrogen. Adequate directions for use and precautionary statements are required for feeds containing non-protein nitrogen as specified in Section 300. (8-16-71)

03. Safe And Effective Use. Adequate directions for use and precautionary statements necessary for safe and effective use are required on commercial feeds distributed to supply particular dietary needs or for supplementing or fortifying the usual diet or ration with any vitamin, mineral, or other dietary nutrient or compound. (8-16-71)

251. -- 299. (RESERVED)

300. NON-PROTEIN NITROGEN.

01. Urea. Urea and other non-protein nitrogen products defined in the Official Publication of the Association of American Feed Control Officials or by the Director are acceptable ingredients only in commercial feeds for ruminant animals as a source of equivalent crude protein. If the commercial feed contains more than eight and seventy-five hundredths percent (8.75%) of equivalent crude protein from all forms of non-protein nitrogen, added as such, or the equivalent crude protein from all forms of non-protein nitrogen, added as such, exceeds one-third (1/3) of the total crude protein, the

label shall bear adequate directions for the safe use of feeds and a precautionary statement: "CAUTION: USE AS DIRECTED." The directions for use and the caution statement shall be in type of such size so placed on the label that they will be read and understood by ordinary persons under customary conditions of purchase and use. (8-16-71)

02. Non-Protein Nitrogen Defined. Non-protein nitrogen defined in the Official Publication of the Association of American Feed Control Officials, when so indicated, are acceptable ingredients in commercial feeds distributed to non-ruminant animals as a source of nutrients other than equivalent crude protein. The maximum equivalent crude protein from non-protein nitrogen sources when used in non-ruminant rations shall not exceed one and twenty-five hundredths percent (1.25%) of the total daily ration. (8-16-71)

03. Labels for Medicated Feeds. On labels such as those for medicated feeds which bear adequate feeding directions and/or warning statements, the presence of added non-protein nitrogen shall not require a duplication of the feeding directions or the precautionary statements as long as those statements include sufficient information to ensure the safe and effective use of this product due to the presence of non-protein nitrogen. (8-16-71)

301. -- 349. (RESERVED)

350. DRUG AND FEED ADDITIVES.

01. Evidence. Prior to approval of a registration application and/or approval of a label for commercial feeds which contain additives (including drugs, other special purpose additives, or non-nutritive additives) the distributor may be required to submit evidence to prove the safety and efficacy of the commercial feed when used according to the directions furnished on the label. (8-16-71)

02. Satisfactory Evidence. Satisfactory evidence of safety and efficacy of a commercial feed may be: (8-16-71)

a. When the commercial feed contains such additives, the use of which conforms to the requirements of the applicable regulation in the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 21, or which are "prior sanctioned" or "generally recognized as safe" for such use, or (8-16-71)

b. When the commercial feed is itself a drug and is generally recognized as safe and effective for the labeled use or is marketed subject to an application approved by the Food and Drug Administration under Title 21 U.S.C. 360(b). (8-16-71)

351. -- 399. (RESERVED)

400. ADULTERANTS.

01. Substances. For the purpose of Section 25-2721 of the Commercial Feed Law, the terms "poisonous or deleterious substances" include but are not limited to the following:
(8-16-71)

a. Fluorine and any mineral or mineral mixture which is to be used directly for the feeding of domestic animals and in which the fluorine exceeds two tenths percent (0.20%) for breeding and dairy cattle; three tenths percent (0.30%) for slaughter cattle; three tenths percent (0.30%) for sheep; thirty-five hundredths percent (0.35%) for lambs; forty five hundredths percent (0.45%) for swine; and six tenths (0.60%) for poultry. (8-16-71)

b. Fluorine bearing ingredients when used in such amounts that they raise the fluorine content of the total ration (exclusive of roughage) above the following amounts: four thousandths percent (0.004%) for breeding and dairy cattle; nine thousandths percent (0.009%) for slaughter cattle; six thousandths percent (0.006%) for sheep; one hundredth percent (0.01%) for lambs; fifteen hundredths percent (0.015%) for swine and three hundredths percent (0.03%) for poultry. (8-16-71)

c. Fluorine bearing ingredients incorporated in any feed that is fed directly to cattle, sheep or goats consuming roughage (with or without) limited amounts of grain, that results in a daily fluorine intake in excess of fifty (50) milligrams of fluorine per one-hundred (100) pounds of body weight. (8-16-71)

d. Soybean meal, flakes or pellets or other vegetable meals, flakes or pellets which have been extracted with trichlorethylene or other chlorinated solvents. (8-16-71)

e. Sulfur dioxide, Sulfurous acid, and salts of Sulfurous acid when used in or on feeds of feed ingredients which are considered or reported to be a significant source of Vitamin B1 (Thiamine). (8-16-71)

02. Screenings Or By-Products. All screenings or by-products of grains and seeds containing weed seeds, when used in commercial feed or sold as such to the ultimate consumer, shall be ground fine enough or otherwise treated to destroy the viability of such weed seeds. (8-16-71)

401. -- 449. (RESERVED)

450. ADOPTIONS AND PROMULGATION.

All rules heretofore adopted and promulgated August 16, 1971 pertaining to the Idaho Commercial Feed Law, Title 25, Chapter 27, Idaho Code, are hereby repealed, and are replaced by the above rules. (8-16-71)

451. -- 499. (RESERVED)

500. COTTONSEED.

01. Certification. Prior to entry into the state of Idaho all shipments of cottonseed or cottonseed seed products destined for animal feed shall be certified as having been sampled and analyzed and no greater amount than twenty (20) ppb of aflatoxin shall be contained within the product or products, except that cottonseed meal intended for use as an animal feed or feed ingredient for beef cattle, swine and poultry, may be certified to contain more than twenty (20) ppb but less than three-hundred (300) ppb of aflatoxin. (4-21-92)

02. Storage Location And Destination. Whole cottonseed, cottonseed meal or cottonseed seed products entering the state certified to contain no greater than twenty (20) ppb aflatoxin, or cottonseed meal certified to contain more than twenty (20) ppb but less than three-hundred (300) ppb aflatoxin shall be accompanied by the certification document aboard carrier, be identified with a storage location at destination, and the certification document shall be maintained on file at the shipment destination for no less than one (1) year. In the case of bulk rail car shipments, the certification document shall accompany the invoice or bill-of-lading and be identified with a storage location at destination. The certification document shall be maintained on file at the shipment destination for no less than one (1) year. (4-21-92)

03. Registration. Idaho firms wishing to import into the state and/or handle cottonseed meal containing more than twenty (20) ppb but less than three-hundred (300) ppb aflatoxin for distribution or sale shall register annually with the Department

TITLE 25
CHAPTER 27
COMMERCIAL FEEDING STUFFS

25-2715. Title. This act shall be known as the "Idaho Commercial Feed Law."

25-2716. Enforcing official. This act shall be administered by the director of the department of agriculture of the state of Idaho, hereinafter referred to as the "director."

25-2717. Definitions of words and terms. When used in this chapter:

a. The term "brand name" means any word, name, symbol or device, or any combination thereof, identifying the commercial feed of a distributor or registrant and distinguishing it from that of others.

b. The term "commercial feed" means all materials or combination of materials which are distributed or intended for distribution for use as feed, or for mixing in feed for poultry and animals other than man except:

1. Unmixed whole seeds and physically altered entire unmixed seeds, when such whole or physically altered seeds are not chemically changed or are not adulterated within the meaning of section 25-2721, Idaho Code.
2. Seeds mixed and planted as such mixture, grown and harvested as one (1) crop and processed as one (1) mixture.
3. All hay except commercially dehydrated legumes and grasses.
4. Whole or ground straw, stover, silage, cobs, husks, hulls, wet beet pulp, pea screenings and beet discard molasses when not mixed with other materials.

The director, by rule, may exempt from this definition, or from specific provisions of this chapter, commodities, and individual chemical compounds or substances when such commodities, compounds or substances are not intermixed with other materials, and are not adulterated according to the provisions of section 25-2721, Idaho Code.

c. The term "contract feeder" means a person who as an independent contractor, feeds commercial feed to animals pursuant to a contract whereby such commercial feed is supplied, furnished, or otherwise provided to such person and whereby such person's remuneration is determined, all or in part, by feed consumption, mortality, profits, or amount or quality of product.

d. The term "customer-formula feed" means commercial feed

which consists of a mixture of commercial feeds and/or feed ingredients each batch of which is manufactured according to the specific instructions of the final purchaser.

e. The term "department" means the Idaho department of agriculture.

f. The term "director" means the director of the Idaho department of agriculture or the director's authorized agent.

g. The term "distribute" means to offer for sale, sell, barter, or otherwise supply commercial feeds or to supply, furnish, or otherwise provide commercial feed to a contract feeder.

h. The term "distributor" means any person who distributes.

i. The term "drug" means any article intended for use in the diagnosis, cure, mitigation, treatment, or prevention of disease in animals other than man and articles other than feed intended to affect the structure or any function of the animal body.

j. The term "feed ingredient" means each of the constituent materials making up a commercial feed.

k. The term "label" means a display of written, printed, or graphic matter upon or affixed to the container in which a commercial feed is distributed, or on the invoice or delivery slip with which a commercial feed is distributed.

l. The term "labeling" means all labels and other written, printed, or graphic matter upon a commercial feed or any of its containers or wrapper, or accompanying such commercial feed.

m. The term "manufacture" means to grind, mix or blend, or further process a commercial feed for distribution.

n. The term "mineral feed" means a commercial feed intended to supply primarily mineral elements or inorganic nutrients.

o. The term "official sample" means a sample of commercial feed taken by the director or an authorized agent in accordance with the provisions of section 25-2723, Idaho Code.

p. The term "percent" or "percentage" means percentage by weight.

q. The term "person" includes individual, partnership, corporation, firm, association, and agent.

r. The term "pet" means any domesticated animal normally maintained in or near the household(s) of the owner(s) thereof.

s. The term "pet food" means any commercial feed prepared and distributed for consumption by dogs and cats.

t. The term "product name" means the name of the commercial feed which identifies it as to kind, class, or specific use.

u. The term "purchase" includes taking by sale, discount, negotiation, mortgage, pledge, lien, issue or reissue, gift or

any other voluntary transaction creating an interest in property.

v. The term "purchaser" means a person who takes by purchase.

w. The term "registrant" means that person, manufacturer, guarantor, or distributor who registers a product or products according to the provisions of section 25-2718, Idaho Code.

x. The term "sell" or "sale" includes exchange.

y. The term "specialty pet" means any domesticated animal pet normally maintained in a cage or tank, such as, but not limited to, gerbils, hamsters, canaries, psittacine birds, mynahs, finches, tropical fish, goldfish, snakes and turtles.

z. The term "specialty pet food" means any commercial feed prepared and distributed for consumption by specialty pets.

aa. The term "ton" means a net weight of two thousand (2,000) pounds avoirdupois.

bb. Words importing the singular number may extend and be applied to several persons or things and words importing the plural may include the singular.

25-2718. Registration. a. Each type of commercial feed except customer-formula feed shall be registered by the person who manufactures or distributes feed within the state of Idaho before being offered for sale, sold, or otherwise distributed in this state. The application for registration shall be submitted to the director on forms furnished by the department of agriculture, and shall be accompanied by a fee of five dollars (\$5.00), except that those feeds sold in packages of ten (10) pounds or less shall be registered for a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), and shall also be accompanied by a label describing the product, unless such label has not been altered since the last registration of the product. A label shall continue in effect unless it is canceled or changed by the registrant or unless canceled by the department of agriculture pursuant to subsection d of this section. All fees paid to the department of agriculture provided for in this section shall be paid to the state treasury, and placed in the commercial feed and fertilizer fund. Upon approval by the director a copy of the registration shall be furnished to the applicant. All registrations expire on September 30 of each year.

b. A distributor shall not be required to register any brand of commercial feed which is already registered under the provisions of this chapter by another person.

c. Changes in the guarantee of either chemical or ingredient composition of a commercial feed may be permitted provided satisfactory evidence is submitted showing that such

changes would not result in a lowering of the feeding value of the product for the purpose for which designed.

d. The director is empowered to refuse registration of any application not in compliance with all provisions of this chapter and to cancel any registration when it is subsequently found to be in violation of any provision of this chapter or when the director has satisfactory evidence that the registrant has used fraudulent or deceptive practices in attempted evasion of the provisions of this chapter or regulations thereunder.

Provided, however, that no registration shall be refused or canceled until the registrant shall have been given opportunity to be heard before the director.

25-2719. Labeling. A commercial feed shall be labeled as follows:

a. A commercial feed, except a customer-formula feed, offered for sale or sold or otherwise distributed in this state in bags, barrels, or other containers shall have placed on or affixed to the container in written or printed form, a label bearing the following information:

1. The net weight (may be stated parenthetically in metric units in addition to the required avoirdupois).
2. The product name and the brand name, if any, under which the commercial feed is distributed.
3. The guaranteed analysis stated in such terms as the director, by regulation, determines is required to advise the user of the composition of the feed or to support claims made in the labeling. In all cases the substances or elements must be determinable by laboratory methods, such as the methods published by the association of official analytical chemists.
4. The common or usual name of each ingredient used in the manufacture of the commercial feed: provided that the director, by regulation, may permit the use of a collective term for a group of ingredients which perform a similar function, or the director may exempt such commercial feeds, or any group thereof, from this requirement of an ingredient statement if the director finds that such statement is not required in the interest of consumers.
5. The name and principal mailing address of the manufacturer or the person responsible for distributing the commercial feed.
6. Adequate directions for use for all commercial feeds containing drugs and for such other feeds as the director may require, by regulation, as necessary for their safe and

effective use.

7. Such precautionary statements as the director, by regulation, determines are necessary for the safe and effective use of the commercial feed.

b. A customer-formula feed shall be accompanied by a label invoice, delivery slip, or other shipping document bearing the following information:

1. Name and address of the manufacturer.
2. Name and address of the purchaser.
3. Date of delivery.
4. The product name and net weight (may be stated parenthetically in metric units in addition to the required avoirdupois) of each commercial feed and the guaranteed analysis, listing the minimum percentage of crude protein, minimum percentage of crude fat, and the maximum percentage of crude fiber.
5. Adequate directions for use for all customer-formula feeds containing drugs and for such other feeds as the director may require, by regulation, as necessary for their safe and effective use.
6. The directions for use and precautionary statements as required by regulation.
7. If a drug-containing product is used:
 - i. The purpose of the medication (claim statement).
 - ii. The established name of each active drug ingredient and the level of each drug used in the final mixture expressed in accordance with regulation.

25-2720. Inspection fees. a. There shall be paid to the department of agriculture for all commercial feeds distributed in this state, an inspection fee at the rate of not more than twenty cents (20¢) per ton, by the registrant except that a person other than the registrant may assume liability for the inspection fee. Fees so collected shall be paid into the state treasury and placed in the "Commercial Feed and Fertilizer Fund" and shall be used to pay the costs of inspection, sampling, analysis, and other expenses necessary for the administration of this chapter. Payment of inspection fees is subject to the following:

1. No fee shall be paid on a commercial feed if the payment has been made by a previous distributor.
2. No fee shall be paid on customer-formula feeds if the inspection fee is paid on the commercial feeds which are used as ingredients therein.
3. No fee shall be paid on commercial feeds which are used as ingredients for the manufacture of commercial feeds which

are registered. If the fee has already been paid, credit shall be given for such payment.

4. Sales of commercial feeds to manufacturers or exchanges between them are hereby exempted if the commercial feeds so sold or exchanged are used solely in the manufacture of feeds which are registered.

5. In the case of a commercial feed which is distributed in the state in packages of ten (10) pounds or less, an annual registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per product shall be paid in lieu of an inspection fee.

6. The minimum inspection fee shall be five dollars (\$5.00) per quarter.

b. Payment of the inspection fee shall be evidenced by a statement made under oath in due form of law, of commercial feed distributed together with documents showing that fees corresponding to the tonnage were received by the director. Every person required to register in accordance with section 25-2718, Idaho Code, shall:

1. File, not later than the last day of January, April, July, October of each year, a quarterly statement under oath, setting forth the number of net tons of commercial feeds distributed in this state during the preceding three (3) month period; and upon filing such statement shall pay the inspection fee at the rate stated in paragraph a of this section.

2. Keep such records as may be necessary or required by the director to indicate accurately the tonnage of commercial feed distributed in this state and the director shall have the right to examine such records to verify statements of tonnage.

3. Inspection fees which are due and owing and have not been remitted to the department within thirty (30) days following the due date shall have a late collection fee of ten percent (10%), but not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), added to the amount due when payment is finally made. The assessment of this late collection fee shall not prevent the director from taking any other action as provided for in this chapter.

Failure to make an accurate statement of tonnage or to pay the inspection fee or comply as provided herein shall constitute sufficient cause for the cancellation of all registrations on file for the distributor.

25-2721. Adulteration. No person shall distribute an adulterated commercial feed. A commercial feed shall be deemed to

be adulterated:

a. If it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance which may render it injurious to health, but in case the substance is not an added substance, such commercial feed shall not be considered adulterated under the provisions of this subsection if the quantity of such substance in such commercial feed does not ordinarily render it injurious to health.

b. If it bears or contains any added poisonous, added deleterious, or added nonnutritive substance which is unsafe within the meaning of section 406 of the federal food, drug, and cosmetic act, as amended, and regulations adopted thereunder other than one which is:

1. A pesticide chemical in or on a raw agricultural commodity; or
2. A food additive.

c. If it is, or it bears or contains any food additive which is unsafe within the meaning of section 409 of the federal food, drug, and cosmetic act, as amended, and regulations adopted thereunder.

d. If it is a raw agricultural commodity and it bears or contains a pesticide chemical which is unsafe within the meaning of section 408 (a) of the federal food, drug and cosmetic act, as amended, and regulations adopted thereunder; provided that where a pesticide chemical has been used in or on a raw agricultural commodity in conformity with an exemption granted or a tolerance prescribed under section 408 of the federal food, drug, and cosmetic act, as amended, and regulations adopted thereunder, and such raw agricultural commodity has been subjected to processing such as canning, cooking, freezing, dehydrating, or milling, the residue of such pesticide chemical remaining in or on such processed feed shall not be deemed unsafe if such residue in or on the raw agricultural commodity has been removed to the extent possible in good manufacturing practice and the concentration of such residue in the processed feed is not greater than the tolerance prescribed for the raw agricultural commodity unless the feeding of such processed feed will result or is likely to result in a pesticide residue in the edible product of the animal, which is unsafe within the meaning of section 408 (a) of the federal food, drug, and cosmetic act, as amended, and regulations adopted thereunder.

e. If it is, or it bears or contains any color additive which is unsafe within the meaning of section 706 of the federal food, drug and cosmetic act, as amended, and regulations adopted thereunder.

f. If it is, or it bears or contains any new animal drug

which is unsafe within the meaning of section 512 of the federal food, drug and cosmetic act, as amended, and regulations adopted thereunder.

g. If any valuable constituent has been in whole or part omitted or abstracted therefrom or any less valuable substance substituted therefor.

h. If its composition or quality falls below or differs from that which it is purported or is represented to possess by its labeling.

i. If it contains added hulls, screenings, straw, cobs, or other high fiber material unless the name of each such material is clearly and prominently stated on the label.

j. If it contains a drug and the methods used in or the facilities or controls used for its manufacture, processing or packaging do not conform to current good manufacturing practice regulations promulgated by the director to assure that the drug meets the requirements of this chapter as to safety. In promulgating such regulations, the director shall adopt the current good manufacturing practice regulations for type A medicated articles and type B and type C medicated feeds established under authority of the federal food, drug, and cosmetic act, unless the director determines that they are not appropriate to the conditions which exist in this state.

k. If it contains viable weed seeds in amounts exceeding the limits which the director shall establish by rule or regulation.

25-2722. Misbranding. No person shall distribute misbranded feed. A commercial feed shall be deemed to be misbranded:

a. If its labeling is false or misleading in any particular.

b. If it is distributed under the name of another feed.

c. If its container is not labeled as required in section 25-2719, Idaho Code, and in regulations prescribed under this chapter.

d. If it purports to be, or is represented as, a commercial feed, or if it purports to contain or is represented as containing a commercial feed ingredient, unless such commercial feed or feed ingredient conforms to the definition, if any, prescribed by regulation by the director.

e. If any word, statement, or other information required by or under authority of this chapter to appear on the label or labeling is not prominently placed thereon with such conspicuousness (as compared with other words, statements, designs or devices, in the labeling) and in such terms as to

render it likely to be read and understood by the ordinary individual under customary conditions of purchase and use.

f. If it purports to be or is represented for special dietary uses, unless its label bears such information concerning its vitamin, mineral, and other dietary properties as the commissioner determines to be, and by regulations prescribes as necessary in order fully to inform purchasers as to its value for such uses.

25-2723. Inspection, sampling, analysis. a. For the purpose of enforcement of this chapter, and in order to determine whether its provisions have been complied with, including whether or not any operations may be subject to such provisions, officers or employees duly designated by the director upon presenting appropriate credentials, to the owner, operator, or agent in charge, are authorized:

(1) [1.] To enter, during normal business hours, any factory, warehouse, or establishment within the state in which commercial feeds are manufactured, processed, packed, or held for distribution, or to enter any vehicle being used to transport or hold such feeds, and

(2) [2.] To inspect, at reasonable times and within reasonable limits and in a reasonable manner, such factory, warehouse, establishment or vehicle and all pertinent equipment, finished and unfinished materials, containers, and labeling therein.

The inspection may include the verification of only such records, and production and control procedures as may be necessary to determine compliance with the good manufacturing practice regulations established under the provisions of this chapter. Each inspection shall be commenced and completed with reasonable promptness. Upon completion of the inspection, the person in charge of the facility or vehicle shall be so notified.

b. Sampling and analysis shall be conducted in accordance with methods published by the association of official analytical chemists, or in accordance with other generally recognized methods.

c. The director, in determining for administrative purposes whether a commercial feed is deficient in any component, shall be guided by the official sample as defined in paragraph (o) of section 25-2717, Idaho Code, and obtained and analyzed as provided for in section 25-2723, Idaho Code.

d. If the owner of any factory, warehouse, or establishment described in subsection a of this section, or authorized agent, refuses to admit the director or an authorized agent to inspect

in accordance with subsections a and e of this section, the director is authorized to obtain from any state court of competent jurisdiction a warrant directing such owner or agent to submit the premises described in such warrant to inspection.

e. For the enforcement of this chapter, the director or a duly authorized agent is authorized to enter upon any public or private premises including any vehicle of transport during regular business hours to have access to, and to obtain samples, and to examine records relating to distribution of commercial feeds.

f. The results of all analyses of official samples shall be forwarded by the director to the registrant and to the purchaser. When the inspection and analysis of an official sample indicate a commercial feed has been adulterated or misbranded and upon request by the registrant or purchaser within thirty (30) days following the receipt of the analysis the director shall furnish to the registrant a portion of the sample concerned.

25-2724. Regulations, standards, definitions. The director is hereby charged with the enforcement of this act, and after due publicity and due public hearing is empowered to promulgate and adopt such reasonable rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry into effect the full intent and meaning of this act. The director is hereby empowered to adopt regulations establishing definitions for commercial feeds and such other regulations as may be necessary for the enforcement of any provision of this act.

25-2725. Detained commercial feeds. a. "Withdrawal from sale or distribution" order. When the director or an authorized agent has reasonable cause to believe a commercial feed is being distributed in violation of any of the provisions of this chapter or of any of the prescribed regulations under this chapter, the director may issue and enforce a written or printed "withdrawal from sale or distribution" order warning the distributor not to dispose of the feed in any manner until written permission is given by the director or the court. The director shall release the commercial feed so withdrawn when the provisions and regulations have been complied with and all costs and expenses incurred in the withdrawal have been paid. If compliance is not obtained within thirty (30) days, the director shall begin proceedings for condemnation.

b. Condemnation and confiscation. Any lot of commercial feed not in compliance with the provisions of this chapter shall be subject to seizure on complaint of the director to a court of
