**Subject: Changes to Idaho's Commercial Feed Rule 02.06.02**

As a past, current or future commercial feed registrant with the Idaho State Department of Agriculture, we wish to make you aware of changes recently made to IDAPA 02.06.02.000, Rules Pertaining to the Idaho Commercial Feed Law. These changes took effect November 29, 2012, after a negotiated rulemaking process in which many of you participated. The changes are as follows:

- That IDAPA 02.06.02.011 (Exemptions from Registration) be amended by the addition of the following language:  
**08. Byproducts or Production Waste.** Processing byproducts or production waste, which do not undergo further processing, received by the end user directly from the fuel or food processor, when not adulterated within the meaning of section 25-2707, Idaho Code, or misbranded within the meaning of section 25-2708, Idaho Code. This may include wet or pressed beet pulp, pea screenings, and beet discard molasses.
- That IDAPA 02.06.02.020 (Registration and Fees) in the Pending and Temporary Rule be revised by changing the registration fee from forty-five (\$45) per product to forty (\$40) per product.
- That IDAPA 02.06.02.020 (Registration and Fees) in the Pending and Temporary Rule be further revised by deleting the following language: "A dedicated fund balance of not more than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) will be maintained. The registration fee will be reduced or increased by the Department in order to maintain this balance."

In summation, the changes outlined above allow for exemption from registration of certain processing byproducts or production waste, and set a registration fee of \$40.00 per product with no limits to the dedicated fund balance.
