This agreement is for one pasture grazing season, for the cattle, duration, and premises described. Permits are issued on a case-by-case basis. Requests should be submitted to the ISDA, Animal Industry Division **at least 15 days before** the move.

CONDITIONS of AGREEMENT
I have <u>initialed</u> each of the statements below showing that I have read, understand and agree to the following:
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. ___ Cattle are from a valid beef breeding herd, established more than six months, moving for grazing purposes <u>without change of ownership.</u> 2. ___ There is to be no movement or diversion of cattle from the premises I have described, unless approved in advance through a Diversion Permit signed by both states. 3. ___ I will account for all animals on this agreement. 4. ___ This agreement is subject to change if the risk of disease changes. 5. ___ Cattle must return <u>to the premises of origin</u> within 6 months, unless approved by the State in advance. 6. ___ All sexually intact cattle 18 months and older have official identification. 7. ___ No trader or recently assembled cattle are in the origin herd of the animals moving. 8. ___ All female cattle over four (4) months of age entering or returning to Idaho are or will be officially brucellosis vaccinated and bear or will bear legible official brucellosis tattoos as evidence of the vaccination. 9. ___ A certificate of veterinary inspection and a brand certificate, in addition to the valid permit, are required for all cattle within the 30 days prior to entering destination state. 10. ___ Copies of the certificate of veterinary inspection, brand certificate and the grazing permit shall accompany each load or part of a shipment of cattle entering Idaho. 11. ___ Failure to comply with the provisions of this agreement and/or any erroneous information provided may result in the revocation of this permit and/or loss of use of any future grazing permits.

Grazing Permit Checklist

- Origin and Destination Information Sections Complete
 - Complete physical addresses and/or GPS coordinates are included

- Herd Information Section is complete
 - Dates of movement are no more than 6-8 months

- Herd Health Information Section is complete
 - Current season Trich PCR test chart is attached
 - DSA cattle - Brucellosis test chart is attached

- Conditions of Agreement are all initialed

- Owner or Representative has signed

- Permit is being submitted *at least* 15 days before anticipated movement.

Note: Incomplete applications or applications missing required information will cause the permit approval process to be delayed.
