

PLEASE WASH YOUR HANDS!

Help protect our produce from contamination by washing your hands.

Workers and Visitors must wash their hands.

When:

- Before starting work
- Before putting on gloves
- After using the toilet
- Before returning to work
- After touching animals or animal waste
- Any other time hands may become contaminated

*21 CFR 112.32 requires employees to wash hands

1. WET HANDS



2. WASH (FOR AT LEAST 20 SECONDS), SCRUBBING WITH SOAP



3. RINSE HANDS THOROUGHLY WITH CLEAN WATER.



4. DRY USING A SINGLE-SERVICE PAPER TOWEL OR OTHER ADEQUATE HAND DRYING DEVICE, SUCH AS A HAND DRYER.



5. THROW THE PAPER TOWEL IN A TRASH CAN.



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
