APPLICATION FOR APPROVED EQUINE FEEDLOT

Idaho Approved Equine Feedlot status expires December 31st of each calendar year. It is the responsibility of feedlot owners and/or management to annually apply for renewal of approved status. Upon written request and after emptying the feedlot of restricted animals, the Approved Horse Slaughter Feedlot status may be dissolved by request of either party.

All animals within an Approved Equine Feedlot will be secure within those areas of the feedlot designated, as approved. Pasturing or grazing animals qualified into the approved feedlot is not allowed. The feedlot must meet all requirements provided for in IDAPA 02.04.21.300 and the following must be accomplished before and during approval:

1. Facility owner or operator must submit a map or graphic showing the specific pens/feedlots on the premises that will be designated to hold horses imported into Idaho for the sole purpose of being fed to slaughter;
2. An ISDA representative must complete an on-site inspection of the facility to verify proper layout and pen capacity;
3. All designated slaughter horses entering into the state of Idaho will be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI), and all records pertaining to the Approved Horse Slaughter Feedlot will be made available upon request by ISDA;
4. Designated slaughter horses may be held for a maximum of sixty (60) days in the Approved Equine Feedlot, after which they must be sent to an approved slaughter establishment;
5. A distance of no less than two hundred (200) yards must be maintained, at all times, between designated slaughter horses (and their respective pens) and all other equidae;
6. Any changes to the approved pens or layout of the premises that impact the proximity of designated slaughter horses to other equidae must be approved by the Administrator; and
7. The applicant will maintain all legally required disease and movement records, including, but not limited to: CVI's, Brand inspections, Backtags and Coggins test results, for all horses in the approved pen.
