Subject: Dairy Byproduct Rulemaking

Stakeholders –

ISDA is looking to complete the rulemaking process for Rules Governing Dairy Byproducts and we would like to schedule one last meeting to finalize all language in the rule and thereby submit a proposed rule for publication in the bulletin. We will need to talk about the results of the soil test experiment that was conducted over the past few months. I plan on presenting all of the data at the meeting, but the quick summary is that there appears to be little consistency in soil testing from one laboratory to another (when each lab tests the same soil sample)...in fact the variability was quite dramatic. Furthermore, there seems to be little consistency from one soil sampler to another (when multiple people collect samples from the same fields and submit them to the same lab).....again, the variability was quite dramatic. So, on our agenda to discuss at this meeting is how to fairly and consistently enforce the phosphorus threshold standard with soil testing being so inconsistent. In a few days, I will also send out the final version of the dairy nutrient management standard that will hopefully be approved by the stakeholders at the meeting so we can submit for consideration by the 2020 Legislature.

We need to find a time that works for all of us to meet...I will suggest May 21st, May 23rd, May 28th or May 30th. Meeting will again be at the ISDA Boise office at 10am. Please email me back with your preference of which day you'd like to meet. Thank you.
