License #1 – Professional Applicator license: Ag Resources issues licenses, in conjunction with a cooperative agreement with USEPA for certification and licensing of professional applicators. Licensees receive routine, announced and unannounced inspections to ensure proper licensing, equipment operation and maintenance, personal protective equipment is correct and being used, if worker protection standards are needed and met, pesticide rates are within label guidelines, weather conditions are within label and ISDA rules, pesticide application records are correct and maintained for the required three year (3) time frame, and that the pesticide is labeled for the application being made.

License #2 – Private Applicator/Chemigation license: Ag Resources issues licenses, in conjunction with a cooperative agreement with USEPA for certification and licensing of private applicators who use Restricted Use Pesticides (RUP). ISDA also licenses chemigators for the use of chemicals through approved chemigation equipment systems. Licensees receive routine, unannounced inspections to ensure proper licensing, equipment operation and maintenance, personal protective equipment is used and correct for the pesticide application, worker protection standards are being met if needed, pesticide rates are within label guidelines, pesticide is labeled for the application being made and if the weather conditions are within label and ISDA rules.

License #3 – Dealer license: Ag Resources issues dealer licenses, in conjunction with a cooperative agreement with USEPA for certification and licensing of restricted use pesticide dealers. Licensees receive routine, announced and unannounced inspections to ensure proper licensing, ensure that all sales of RUPs are sold to only properly licensed applicators, records of all sales of RUPs are maintained and for three (3) years, RUP inventory is kept and current, proper pesticide storage posting is in place, and all opened containers of pesticides are properly stored for end use, or in a properly posted not for sale area.

Assessment of Public Interest

License #1: Milk Processing Facilities: Dairy Bureau issues licenses, on behalf of the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), for milk processing plants to receive milk from dairy farms and process the milk into various dairy products. Licensees receive routine, unannounced inspections to ensure food safety, sanitation and equipment maintenance are meeting the standards approved by FDA for handling and processing milk.

License #2: Dairy Farm: Dairy Bureau issues Grade A Milk Permits to dairy farms that wish to sell milk for human consumption. Permittees receive routine, unannounced inspections to ensure food safety, sanitation and equipment maintenance are meeting the standards approved by FDA for collecting and handling Grade A milk.

License #3: Bulk Hauler License: Dairy Bureau issues licenses to individuals that transport milk from dairy farms to milk processing plants. Licensees receive routine, unannounced inspections to ensure sanitation and equipment maintenance are meeting the standards approved by FDA for handling and transportation of Grade A milk.

ISDA Animal Industries/Dairy Bureau

License #4: Small Herd Raw Milk: Dairy Bureau issues permits to individuals that sell raw, unpasteurized milk for human consumption. Permittees herd sizes are limited to a maximum of seven (7) goats or sheep and/or three (3) cows. Permittees must submit monthly milk samples for testing to ensure milk quality meets state standard for raw milk sold for human consumption.

License #5: Poultry CAFO. Dairy Bureau issues permits to large poultry operations that will be collecting, storing and managing the waste produced from the birds. Permittees must obtain construction approvals prior to building waste containment lagoons, to assure construction requirements are in accordance with state law. Permittees also receive unannounced annual inspections to ensure proper management of all waste storage and containment facilities. The annual fees collected from the permittees fund the annual inspection process.

License #6: Milk and Cream Procurement and Testing. Dairy Bureau issues licenses to laboratories that test Grade A milk for producer payments to ensure laboratories are accurately performing the tests. Participating labs receive milk samples twice a month to verify testing accuracy.

License #1: Milk Processing Facilities: This program is conducted under the authority of the Food and Drug Administration and requires milk processed for human consumption to meet these quality standards, inspection frequencies and enforcement provisions to maintain the permit. No recommendations.

License #2: Dairy Farm: This program is conducted under the authority of the Food and Drug Administration and requires milk collected and shipped for human consumption to meet these quality standards, inspection frequencies and enforcement provisions to maintain the permit. No recommendations.

License #3: Bulk Hauler License: This program is conducted under the authority of the Food and Drug Administration and requires milk transported for human consumption and the vehicles used to move the product to meet these quality standards, inspection frequencies and enforcement provisions to maintain the permit. No recommendations.

ISDA Animal Industries/Dairy Bureau

License #4: Small Herd Raw Milk: Improve the permitting process by allowing online, electronic submission of application documents and animal testing documents. This is a voluntary program with no fees.

License #5: Poultry CAFO. Improve the permitting process by allowing online, electronic submission of application documents and online payment options for annual fee assessments.

License #6: Milk and Cream Procurement and Testing. Improve the permitting process by clarifying rule requirements for testing standards and license re-application procedure. The rule language is confusing and needs revision. Negotiated rulemaking for this rule has been scheduled for the summer of 2018 to be considered by the 2019 Idaho Legislature.

1. Rendering establishments and establishments processing 4-D animals are to be constructed in such a manner as to protect the finished product and to prevent pollution of surrounding environment or creation of a nuisance to the public.
2. Rendering material is transported to the rendering establishment in covered and leak-proof vehicles to be used for this purpose only and be cleaned and disinfected after delivering each load.
3. Rendering material is heated to a sufficient temperature for a sufficient length of time to destroy all pathogens and processed under sanitary procedures that prohibit the recontamination of the product after cooking.
4. The finished product shall be transported from the rendering establishment or the establishment processing 4-D animals in a clean vehicle in such a manner that will prevent contamination.

These requirements not only protect the integrity of the product, but also provide disease prevention for Idaho livestock as well as protections to public health, wildlife and the environment.

The Warehouse license requires the licensee to be examined annually to verify producers are receiving payments for their commodity, the company is solvent, and the company can meet producer storage obligations. The licensee must provide an annual independently audited or reviewed financial statement in order to renew, which helps illustrate a company's solvency.

License #2; Weighmaster License: The Weighmaster license provides minimum qualifications to individuals conducting weighments of certain commodities. The weighmaster also represents the buyer and seller when they are not present at the time of the weighing.

License #3; Registered Servicemen or Agency License: The Registered Servicemen or Agency license is a voluntary program that establishes criteria for individuals or agencies wanting the authority to remove official rejection tags from devices or place a device into service until such time as an official examination can be made.

- Under 18 years of age
- Inability to weigh accurately and make correct weight tickets
- Having a previous weighmaster license revoked
- Failure to furnish satisfactory evidence of good moral character

Opinion: Remove the provision; to furnish satisfactory evidence of good moral character as defined in Title 71-402, Idaho Code. This requirement is subjective, undefined, and may be open to bias.

License #3; Registered Servicemen or Agency License: This is a voluntary program with no fees. No recommendations.
