AGENDA ITEMS

WELCOME

Lloyd Knight convened the meeting at 9:05 a.m. He explained that this is a combination of rules into one chapter. The code sites were reviewed and redundant language eliminated. Since this is not the normal time of year for negotiated rulemaking, no substantive changes were made. The comment period ends September 20. The proposed rule will be published in the November Bulletin. He explained that the involvement of stakeholders in the legislative process is important and thanked those who attended the meeting.

Lloyd Knight showed on the website where to find the rules that are being combined. He indicated that the legal authority allows for the rules. The historical dates should remain for reference. He also stated that some restrictive language including “shalls” have been removed. He then scrolled through the rule to point out the combinations and changes. The rules being combined into “IDAPA 02.06.04 Rules Governing Plant Exports” include:

IDAPA 02.06.04 Phytosanitary and Post-Entry Certification Rules;
IDAPA 02.06.34 Rules Concerning Virus-free Certification of Nursery Stock; and
IDAPA 02.06.40 Rules Governing Ginseng Export

Lloyd Knight adjourned the meeting at 9:20 a.m.
