It has come to the attention of this office that there is considerable ice being sold in Idaho that is in violation of Idaho Weights & Measures Laws and Regulations.

Idaho Code 71-233 requires that any package commodity shall bear on the outside of the package (1) the identity of the commodity, (2) the quantity of contents, and (3) where the package is not sold where packed, the name and address of the manufacturer or distributor.

This letter is to inform those concerned that any product not bearing the required labeling (See Idaho Package & Labeling Regulations, Section 4.7, Prominence and Placement: Consumer Packages) shall not be allowed in the marketplace after July 1, 1978.

The July 1, 1978 deadline is to allow those without proper labeling time to acquire proper packaging material.
