I was disappointed that the last legislative session did not succeed in improving the pesticide spraying rules.

I am hopeful that the current rulemaking process can improve the situation. Farmworkers should not be sprayed. The rules need to make sprayers responsible if they do not follow safe practices, such as avoiding times when wind will cause spray to affect workers in the area, or nearby crops which will be harmed by the chemicals.

The contention that there are enough rules on the labels of the pesticides used is absolutely not adequate. There need to be clear and enforceable rules with real penalties for disobeying such rules.
