I think the proposed rules for the spraying of pesticides are inadequate and need to be strengthened. The health and safety of farm workers and residents of rural Idaho are at stake.

Residents and workers should be notified of spraying. There should be at least a one mile buffer zone around hazard zones unless the wind is blowing away from the hazard area. When winds are over 10 mph there should be no spraying. There should be Idaho specific wind speed restrictions.
