I saw that the Rules cover the AI category for Agricultural Insecticide/Fungicide applications.

Or is the Farm employee ok to apply the miticide under the farming operation's Private Applicator license? I just need to get this right in my mind.

Correct. If it is a grower with a Private applicators license. His employee does not need the CA category and can apply under his license as long as they trained to a handler under WPS. The CA category is for professional applicators.
