Contiguous Location and Buildings for Handler

A contiguous site will <u>NOT</u> have separate addresses. Any buildings with separate addresses shall be considered two or more separate sites. All buildings, contiguous or separate, will require individual building information, map outlines, and GPS coordinates for each.

Is This a Contiguous Location? **Examples (Buildings)** Building - A **YES**, this is one contiguous location of one building at one site and one address. YES, this is one contiguous location of two Building – A Building - B buildings at one site and one address. **NO**, this is not one contiguous location with Building - A Building - B buildings due to the buildings being down the road from each other with separate addresses. Therefore, this would be viewed as two separate buildings at two separate sites and two addresses.



NO, although Building A and B are within one contiguous location with one address, the building across the street is a separate address. Therefore, this would be viewed as three separate buildings, two separate sites, and two addresses.



YES, this is one contiguous location of three buildings at one site and one address.
