









Contiguous Location and Lots for Producer

A contiguous lot/field will **NOT** have multiple varieties of hemp, or the same variety of hemp planted multiple times in the same field over an extended period of time. A contiguous lot/field may **NOT** contain any breaks, fence lines, trees or brush lines, canals or bodies of water, or roads dividing the field. Any field with these types of divisions shall be considered two or more separate fields and lots. Each lot will require individual lot information, map outlines and GPS coordinates for each.

Individual greenhouses/indoor growing facilities are considered separate and require GPS coordinates. Different varieties within a greenhouse or indoor growing structure are considered separate lots.

Is This a Contiguous Location?	Examples (Fields and Facilities)
<p>YES, this is one contiguous growing location of one field with one variety.</p>	
<p>NO, this is not one contiguous location of one field with one variety due to the field being divided by trees or brush. Therefore, this would be viewed as two separate lots in two separate fields.</p>	
<p>NO, this is not one contiguous location of one field with one variety due to the field being divided by canal or water. Therefore, this would be viewed as two separate lots in two separate fields.</p>	
<p>NO, this is not one contiguous location of one field with one variety due to the field being divided by fence. Therefore, this would be viewed as two separate lots in two separate fields.</p>	

<p>NO, this is not one contiguous location due to the field growing two different varieties. Therefore, this would be viewed as two separate lots in two separate fields.</p>	
<p>NO, this is not one contiguous location due to the field growing area being twenty feet apart. Therefore, this would be viewed as two separate lots in two separate fields.</p>	
<p>YES, this is one contiguous growing location viewed as one building with one lot.</p>	
<p>NO, this is not one contiguous location due to two separate buildings or two different varieties within the building. Therefore, this would be viewed as two separate lots in one building.</p>	<p>Variety - A Variety - B</p> 
<p>NO, this is not one contiguous location due to two separate buildings. Therefore, this would be viewed as two separate lots in two separate buildings.</p>	<p>Variety - A Variety - A</p>
