The meeting was called to order by Lloyd Knight at 9:01am. Lloyd introduced this meeting as the first rulemaking meeting for 02.02.11 Rules Governing Eggs & Egg Products. Lloyd directed all meeting participants to the Townhall website for up-to-date meeting information, and to the ISDA website for additional handouts, documents, and information on this year's rulemaking.

REVIEW OF CURRENT RULE AND PROPOSED CHANGES

Dr. Leibsle introduced the rule for everyone. The rule was presented on screen for everyone. The participants collectively reviewed the rule section by section and the recommended edits. The majority of the edits comprise of adding an Incorporation by Reference document of 7 CFR Part 56 and removing duplicative language. This is the July 20, 2000 Edition of the United States Standards, Grades, and Weight Classes for Shell Eggs. The majority of the rule pulls language from this CFR.

Section 550 – This section was removed as it is not feasible to enforce. This type of operation is done mostly out of state.

Section 600 – This section is no longer applicable. Nobody prepays for tax seals anymore.

Dr. Leibsle asked if there was additional questions. No other comments or questions were submitted.
