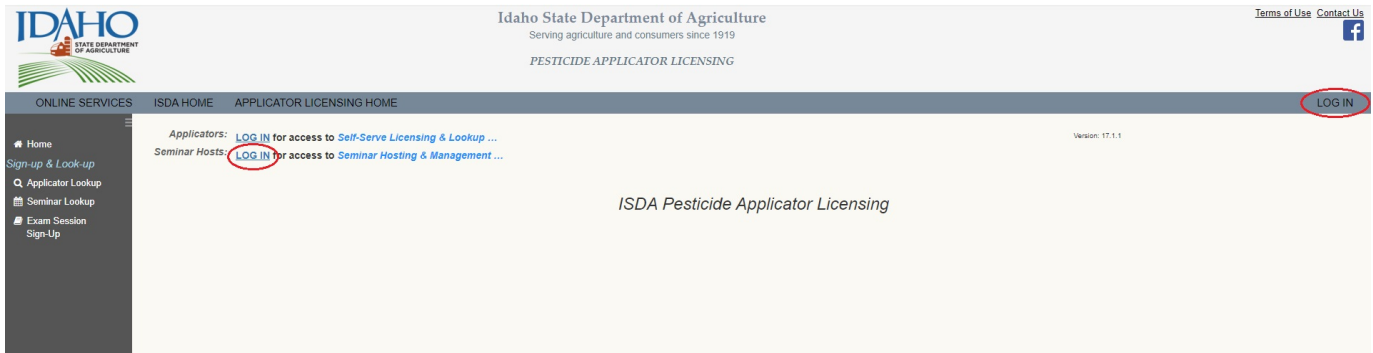


Creating a seminar host profile

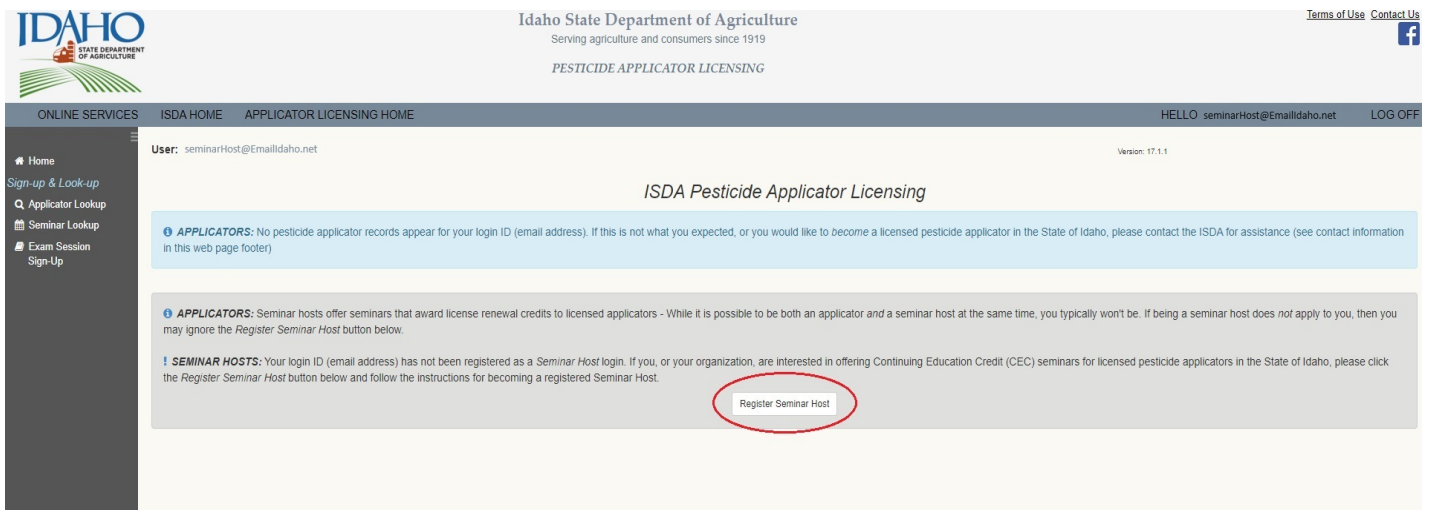
Seminar hosts can submit seminars and attendance rosters through an on-line portal.

1. Browse to the ISDA Applicator Licensing website at <https://applicatorlicensing.isda.idaho.gov> and click 'LOG IN'



2. USE THE SEMINAR HOST'S EMAIL ADDRESS as the user ID when logging in. This will typically be a seminar hosting organization's email address that is utilized only for seminar hosting activities.

*If this email address does not work, then you may need to click the Set Up Online Access link to set it up as a user ID in our SSO system (details not covered here).



Register as a Seminar Host

If you or your organization would like to sponsor seminars for pesticide applicators to earn continuing education credits (CECs), then click the *Continue* button below, otherwise click the *Cancel* button ...

IMPORTANT

- Seminar Registration Requests are associated with a single email login. We recommend utilizing a single shared email login and password for registering and running seminars. If you register seminars under more than one email account, then you will have to log into those separate accounts in order to access the additional registrations.

Note: Registration as a seminar host permits you to submit new seminar registration requests. Once requests have been reviewed and approved, the requested seminar will appear in our list of available seminars.

Clicking the **Submit Seminar Host Registration** button (below) will send an email to the ISDA to request registration as a seminar host. Once the ISDA has registered you as a seminar host, then a **Seminar Submissions** link will appear in the sidebar menu where you can initiate new seminar registration requests.

APPLICATORS: Seminar hosts offer seminars that award license renewal credits to licensed applicators.
