COMPLIANCE DATES FOR SUBPART E: *Harvest and Post-Harvest Agricultural Water Only*

As of January 26, 2024, all small covered farms are required to comply with the harvest and post-harvest agricultural water requirements of Subpart E. FDA has released a new <u>fact sheet</u> that provides a reminder to farmers of the requirements for harvest and postharvest agricultural water.

Harvest and post-harvest agricultural water requirements for very small farms covered under the Produce Safety Regulation are expected to comply beginning January 26, 2025.

Note: Qualified exempt farms are already required to submit a new verification form annually. If your operation holds a qualified exemption and you have not submitted a new verification for 2024, please **give us a call** --->

DID YOU KNOW?

Farms must notify ISDA any time there is a significant change with their operation such as average produce and/or food sales, or a change in produce grown. Simply give us a call, send an email, or submit a new <u>verification form</u>.
