CANADA CERTIFICATION REINSTATED

The ISSL has completed the Canadian Certification process and can proceed with completing analysis of samples intended for Canadian grading and certification.

CANADIAN TEST PRICES

With Canada tests reinstated, please see the table for the updated relevant testing fees. All other laboratory fees will remain the same.

The Canadian Purity test includes a Canadian Noxious weed test, so that will not need to be selected separately.

Canada analyses can be selected in addition to any of the below analyses, depending on needs



- ICIA PURITY (includes Idaho noxious)
- GERMINATION

Select these tests if the seed lot is also needing any of the following:

- Testing according to ICIA standards
- Certified, Registered, or Foundation seed
- Labeling in USA



- PURITY
- NOXIOUS (select Idaho, All States, Western States, or other specified state or country)
- GERMINATION

Select these tests if the seed lot is also intended for standard labeling in USA or export to a foreign country
